Suggestions are also printed on the back of this flyer. These school supplies will be given to social workers, teachers, counselors, schools, agencies and organizations to be distributed to the needy students they serve. *THANKS!*
- 3. No time to shop? Write a check payable to St. Mary's with "School Supplies" in the memo line and give it to the receptionist at the Parish Center. These funds will be used to purchase additional backpacks and school supplies needed to fill the many requests made to our parish. THANKS!
