News from the Pastor...

As we look forward to opening up our church for public Mass, in the next phase, on May 29th, there are several things we need to keep in mind.

BISHOP'S DISPENSATION

Firstly, our Bishop has excused anyone who doesn't feel safe from attending Mass, especially those who are 60 years and older. As the elderly are the most vulnerable and there is always a risk with this illness, we want you to be safe. I am asking those who are in this category to refrain from ministering at Mass during this time. You may still attend Mass if you choose to.

MASS ATTENDANCE PROTOCOL

This is also the reason that I am asking that anyone who attends Mass to wear a mask. Remember this is not for your protection but for the protection of the people around you.

The Governor has set the next phase of opening at 50% occupancy with continued social distancing. This means that we cannot have more than 92 people in the Worship Center at any one time. We will also set up Farrell Hall for an overflow at the same time of Mass.

During Holy Communion I am asking you to prayerfully consider receiving in the hand. You do have the right to receive on the tongue but if you do, we will have to purify our fingers every time you do.

At this time only the priests and deacons are allowed to give out Holy Communion.

If the Governor pushes back the next phase of opening up, we will introduce Communion Services which we can offer for 10 people at a time.

LIVESTREAMING IMPROVEMENTS

Thanks to the generosity of parishioners we are going to upgrade our A/V system for better livestreaming as soon as we can. We will continue to live stream the Masses and other liturgical events.

Please continue to check back on our website for the latest information and know that your priests and deacons are praying for you every day.



Papal Blessings

Papal Blessing Parchments

The gift of an Apostolic Blessing, formally inscribed on parchment and sent from Rome, is a traditional means of marking milestone events such as wedding anniversaries, baptisms, first communions, confirmations and significant birthdays. These parchments are produced by the Holy See's Office of Papal Charities, or Elemosineria Apostolica, which is charged with exercising charity to the poor in the name of the Holy Father. Since the time of Pope Leo XIII, the production of these parchments has served as an important means of funding charitable works. Papal Blessing Parchments may now be ordered online directly from the Elemosineria Apostolica using their website,www.elemosineria.va (click on "Papal Blessing Parchments"). A number of beautiful formats are available for each type of event.

Requesting a Papal Blessing Parchment

The procedure to request a Papal Blessing has changed. Papal Blessing Parchments can be ordered online at www.elemosineria.vaby and clicking on "Papal Blessing Parchments" at the top of the page. (The website can also be located by searching online for "Office of Papal Charities.") Parchments can be paid for online using a credit card; completed Parchments will be sent to the recipient via DHL Express.

Please be aware that the new procedures include limits on the types of occasions for which Blessing Parchments may be requested ("general blessings" are no longer available), and also limits on how long before or after an occasion a Parchment may be ordered.




