Faith, Hope and Love, let these endure among you. Faith, Hope and Love, and the greatest of these is love.


The love of Christ has gathered us together; let us rejoice in him. Let us fear and love our God, the living God, let us love, let us love, each other.

Therefore when we are gathered together, let us be one in mind; Let there be an end to bitterness and strife, in our midst, in our midst be Christ.


