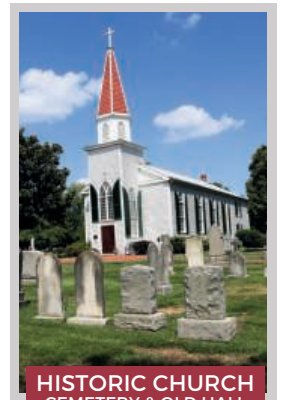

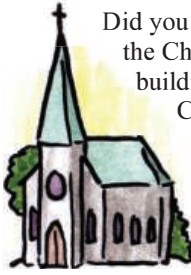
IN THEIR OWN WORDS:

Route 123 Clean-up

Virginia’s Adopt-a-Highway Program, in which individuals or organization periodically clean up an assigned section of road, is a cooperative venture run by the State which depends on the willingness of volunteers to do the work. The Knights of Columbus St. Mary of Sorrows Council 8600 has been cleaning a section of Route 123 (Ox Road) which begins at the Historic Church and runs south to Chapel Road since 1989; and it is one of the oldest continually running ministries in the parish. The road is cleaned four times a year, and it usually takes about two hours to complete it. The Knights are offering ALL parishioners an opportunity to join with them in this activity. It is good exercise, gets you outdoors, provides a way to keep the area where you live clean and neat, is an opportunity for those who require community service hours, and to serve as a good neighbor, as Christ desires. All children under the age of 18 need to be accompanied by a parent/guardian or adult – make it a family service event! The next clean-up is scheduled for Saturday morning, **June 1, 2024**. 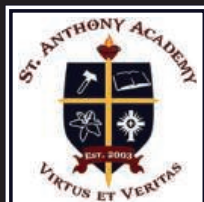
