PARISH LIFE

From the Pastor...

In the first five hundred years of Christianity/Catholicism, there were many Christian writers – most are referred to as ‘Church Fathers’. The writings that we still have fill well over ten volumes. All these fathers of the Church are in agreement on the basic truths of the Catholic Faith: the pope is the head of the Church, the Holy Eucharist is the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus, Blessed Mother and the saints are to be revered and asked for intercession, etc.

There is one early Church Father who lends great support to the faith. St. Irenaeus lived from 140 AD – 202 AD. He was taught by another saint/martyr, Polycarp. St. Polycarp was taught by St. John the Apostle! Irenaeus wrote extensively on matters of the Faith. He is the first to give us a list of popes – the first thirteen. He identifies the Gospel writers as Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. He further explains who each one was: Matthew was an Apostle, as was John, Luke was a disciple of St. Paul and Mark was a disciple of St. Peter. Irenaeus also quotes from the New Testament 1,819 times. (These quotations match quotations by other early Church Fathers who lived in other parts of the world.)

Historically, the Catholic Church is Apostolic; It traces Itself, through the popes and bishops, to the Apostles and Jesus Christ!

Parish-wide Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary

September 2024 - The Feast of Our Lady of
Sorrows

The 33-day preparation for Total Consecration
begins August 13, 2024



What is Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary?

Total consecration to Jesus through Mary and exercise to increase our spirituality and ability to truly serve our Lord, Jesus Christ. Jesus came into the world through Mary and for us to be close to Jesus, we should go through Mary. Consecration means to set aside for a sacred purpose. Mary's life was set aside so to serve our Lord. We, too, can completely give ourselves to Christ by consecrating ourselves to Him.

How does it work?

The consecration is set forth by St. Louis de Montfort consists of a 33-day period of prayerful preparation, followed by the actual act of consecration. The 33-day preparation begins with a period of 12 days during which we endeavor "to free ourselves from the spirit of the world." That initial 12 days is followed by a second period of three weeks. The first which is devoted to the knowledge of ourselves, the second to that of the Blessed Virgin, and the third to that of Jesus Christ.

Jesus still multiplies what we give Him today. At Mass we offer to God some bread and wine and He turns it into the Body and Blood of Jesus!



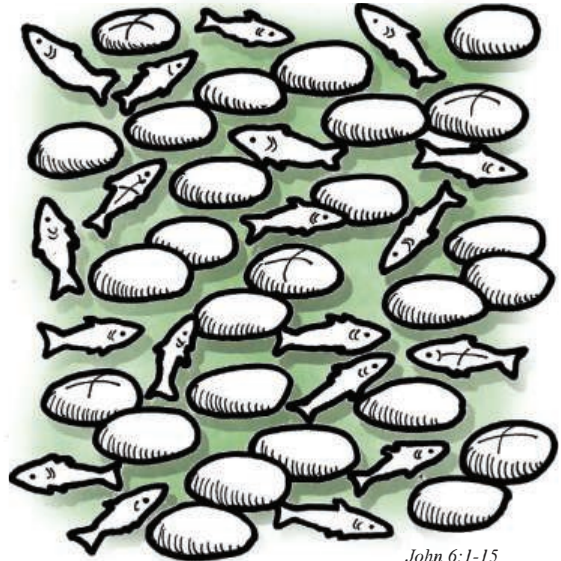
We have something to offer to Jesus too. If you offer your work, or your talents, or even your whole life to God, He will use your gifts to bring His blessings to the world.
