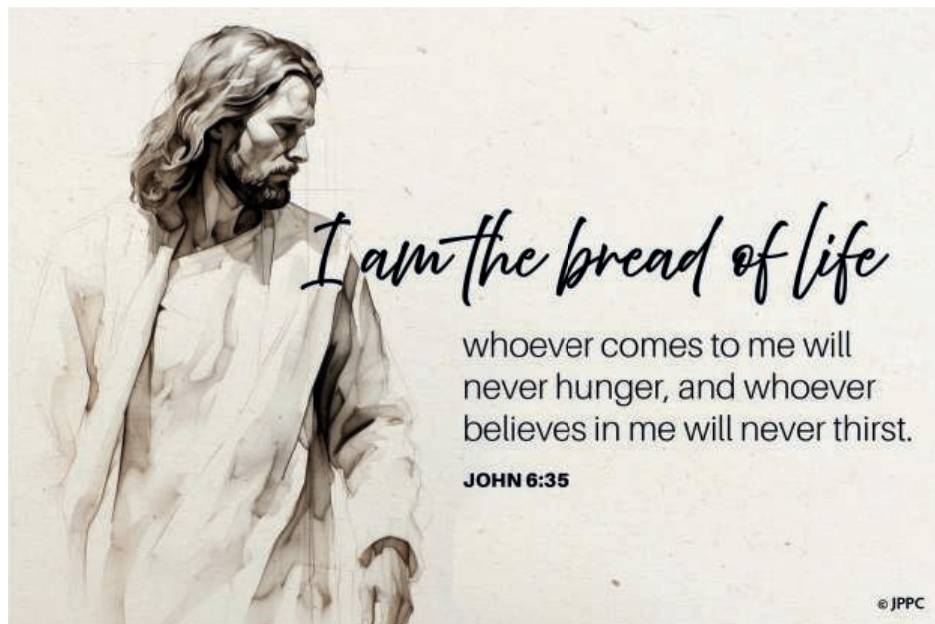

From the Pastor...

Two weeks ago, Catholics in America celebrated the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. There were four Eucharistic Processions from around the country – north, south, east and west - that finished in Indianapolis for the Congress.

A Eucharistic Congress is held to highlight Jesus really, truly and substantially present in the Holy Eucharist. There were many talks on the Holy Eucharist to the 50,000 participants. There was Eucharistic Adoration throughout the Congress. There was one major Eucharistic Procession through the streets of Indianapolis which included thousands of laity and consecrated.

It is good for us to re-affirm our faith in Jesus' Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Every time we pass a Catholic Church, we can make an act of belief and love to Jesus in the tabernacle. It could be simply making a Sign of the Cross. It may be one of the phrases from the Scriptures, i.e. St. Thomas the Apostle, 'Lord, I believe; help my unbelief.'

Each time we enter a Catholic Church, we are in Jesus' Presence. When we genuflect out of love and reverence for Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, it is an opportunity to tell our Lord we love Him.

What a great gift we have to be able to visit Jesus so often in our tabernacles! What an incredible opportunity is ours to receive Him in Holy Communion at Mass! St. Maximilian Kolbe once remarked, "If angels could be jealous of man, they would be for one reason: Holy Communion."

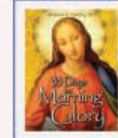

Parish-wide Total Consecration to Jesus through
Mary

September 2024 - The Feast of Our Lady of
Sorrows

The 33-day preparation for Total Consecration
begins August 13, 2024



**What is Total Consecration to Jesus through
Mary?**

Total consecration to Jesus through Mary and exercise to increase our spirituality and ability to truly serve our Lord, Jesus Christ. Jesus came into the world through Mary and for us to be close to Jesus, we should go through Mary. Consecration means to set aside for a sacred purpose. Mary's life was set aside so to serve our Lord. We, too, can completely give ourselves to Christ by consecrating ourselves to Him.

How does it work?

The consecration is set forth by St. Louis de Montfort consists of a 33-day period of prayerful preparation, followed by the actual act of consecration. The 33-day preparation begins with a period of 12 days during which we endeavor "to free ourselves from the spirit of the world." That initial 12 days is followed by a second period of three weeks. The first which is devoted to the knowledge of ourselves, the second to that of the Blessed Virgin, and the third to that of Jesus Christ.

The complementary book "33 days to Morning Glory" will be available in the Narthex starting August 10.

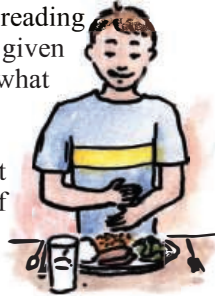
Jesus in the Eucharist

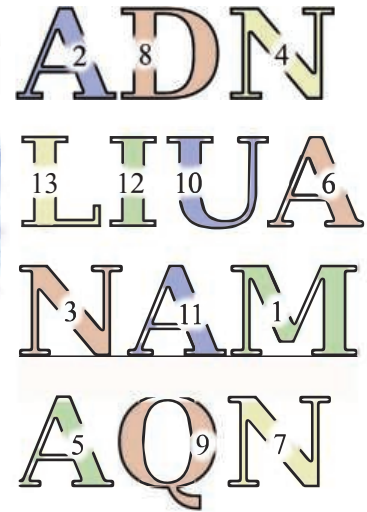


