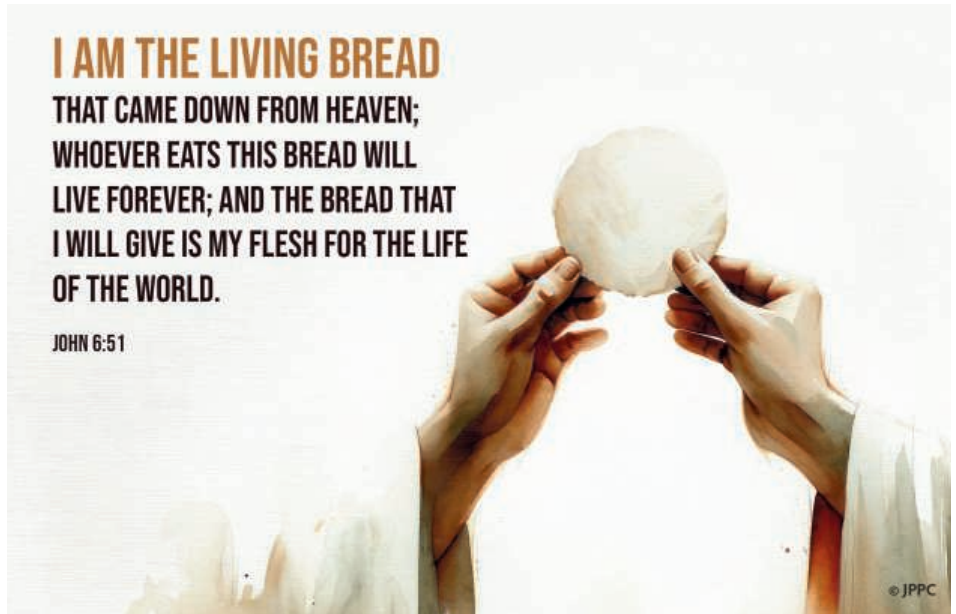

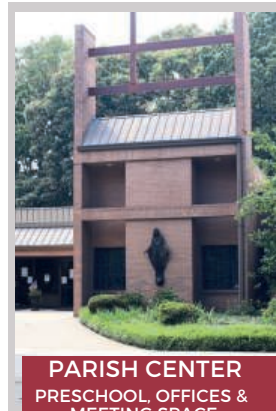

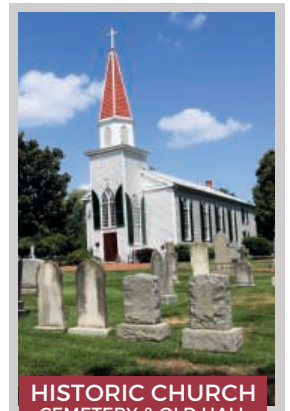

**From the Pastor...**

Imagine if your 15 year-old daughter came home and told you she was going to give up everything the world has to offer and follow a make-shift band of religious beggars dedicated to God?! What if, after many attempts to have her married, she ran away to the said band of religious?

Such is the beginning of the consecrated life of St. Clare of Assisi. When Clare's father and uncles came to take her home, she would not let go of the altar. Her father finally relented when she removed her veil to show him her beautiful golden hair was gone; she had asked St. Francis to cut it.

Clare would not compromise with the secular world. She would make her vows of poverty, chastity and obedience before St. Francis and his friars. Agnes, Clare's sister, would follow just a couple weeks later. At the age of 21, Francis bound Clare under obedience to be the superior of the women's branch of his order, now known as the Poor Clares. Clare would faithfully fulfill this role for 38 years until her death in 1253. She was canonized two years later.

How could a life of solitude, poverty and penance be so appealing to this beautiful young lady?! How many would say, 'What a waste'? Clare saw a life completely dedicated to Jesus as a joyful, beautiful life. She grew up with comfort and possessions. These did not fulfill her. She found fulfillment in a cloistered monastery separated from the world.

May we learn from St. Clare where true fulfillment and joy are found!

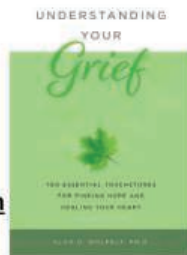

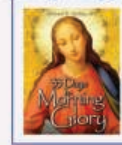

Parish-wide Total Consecration to Jesus through  
Mary

September 2024 - The Feast of Our Lady of  
Sorrows

The 33-day preparation for Total Consecration  
begins August 13, 2024



### What is Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary?

Total consecration to Jesus through Mary and exercise to increase our spirituality and ability to truly serve our Lord, Jesus Christ. Jesus came into the world through Mary and for us to be close to Jesus, we should go through Mary. Consecration means to set aside for a sacred purpose. Mary's life was set aside so to serve our Lord. We, too, can completely give ourselves to Christ by consecrating ourselves to Him.

### How does it work?

The consecration is set forth by St. Louis de Montfort consists of a 33-day period of prayerful preparation, followed by the actual act of consecration. The 33-day preparation begins with a period of 12 days during which we endeavor "to free ourselves from the spirit of the world." That initial 12 days is followed by a second period of three weeks. The first which is devoted to the knowledge of ourselves, the second to that of the Blessed Virgin, and the third to that of Jesus Christ.

Narthex starting August 10.





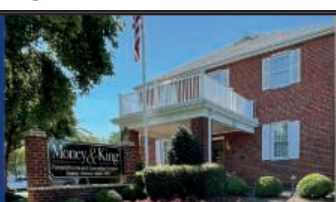
