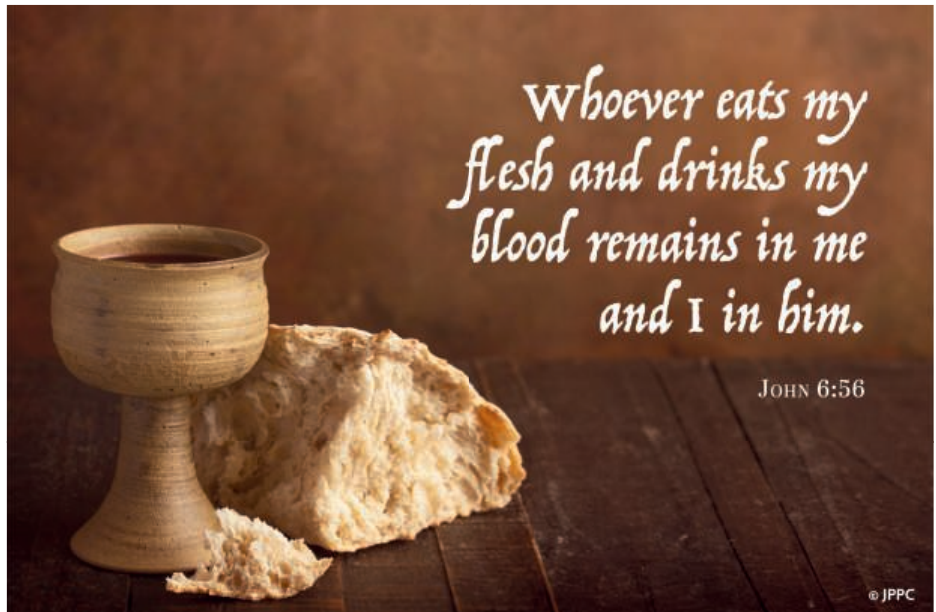

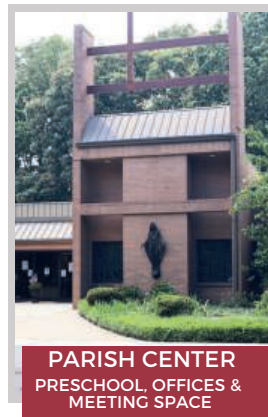

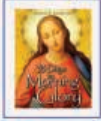

**Parish-wide Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary
September 15, 2024 - The Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows**



The 33-day preparation for Total Consecration began August 13, 2024

What is Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary?

Total consecration to Jesus through Mary and exercise to increase our spirituality and ability to truly serve our Lord, Jesus Christ. Jesus came into the world through Mary and for us to be close to Jesus, we should go through Mary. Consecration means to set aside for a sacred purpose. Mary's life was set aside so to serve our Lord. We, too, can completely give ourselves to Christ by consecrating ourselves to Him.

How does it work?

The consecration is set forth by St. Louis de Montfort consists of a 33-day period of prayerful preparation, followed by the actual act of consecration. The 33-day preparation begins with a period of 12 days during which we endeavor "to free ourselves from the spirit of the world." That initial 12 days is followed by a second period of three weeks. The first which is devoted to the knowledge of ourselves, the second to that of the Blessed Virgin, and the third to that of Jesus Christ.

Complementary books "33 days to Morning Glory" are now available for pick up in the Narthex.

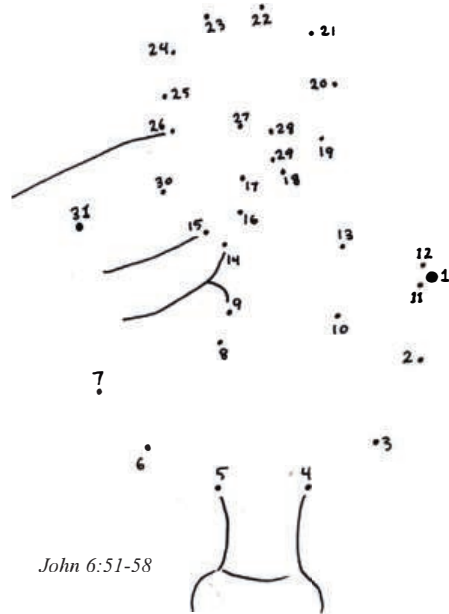
