### From the Pastor..

Thank you to everyone who participated in the St. Mary of Sorrows' Annual Picnic!

As a first-time participant, it is tremendous to see so much cooperation and joy! Thank you to all who gave of their time and talents in preparation, day of or clean-up.

Our 147th Picnic coincides with our diocesan 50th anniversary. St. Mary of Sorrows, 147 years ago, was part of the diocese of Richmond. The diocese of Arlington was established in 1974, taken from the northern area of the diocese of Richmond. As part of our diocesan 50th celebration, Bishop Burbidge has renovated our cathedral. The consecration of the new altar was on September 5th. The cathedral is the 'mother' church for us in our diocese. It is where the 'cathedra' or the 'chair of the bishop' is located. Going back to the Old Testament, the chair is a symbol of the authority of the one who sits upon it (think of the throne of a king or queen). We should recall that Jesus sat often to teach.

The bishop is our spiritual authority who ties us to the Holy Father, the Pope. The Pope is our tie to Christ. If one is in union with one's bishop, he is in union with the pope. If he is in union with the pope, he is in union with Christ. St. Ambrose, Bishop of Milan, once wrote, "Where there is Peter, there is the Church. Where there is the Church, there is Christ."

Thank you, Lord, for your gift of the Church, the gift of this diocese, the gift of our bishop.
