Fathers Cummings and Seh, Deacons Nick, Jeff and Dave, and I would like to thank all of you for your generosity at Christmas. May Our Lord reward your generosity!

As we continue our celebration of Christmas we come this weekend to Epiphany. Traditionally, Epiphany was celebrated on January 6th – 12 days after Christmas. If you ever visit the beautiful cathedral of Cologne, Germany you will find three tombs there. These tombs house the relics of the three wise men, Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar. Their relics were brought from the east by Christians.

Epiphany is the celebration of the manifestation of Jesus Christ to the world – the non-Jews – as the three wise men traveled from the limits of the known world at the time. They represent all of us as they bring their gifts before Our Lord. Their gifts were gold, frankincense and myrrh. Each has a significance: gold for the King of kings; frankincense for God; myrrh for man.

As the three wise men kneel before their God in honor and worship, they teach us that we are called to do the same before the King of kings and God-man. In order to recognize Jesus, it is necessary to humble oneself before Him. It is necessary to kneel before Him in Adoration at Mass. It is necessary to kneel before Him as we embrace His plan for each of us. It is necessary to kneel before Him as we embrace His truth. In order to live a truly human life it is necessary to kneel before our humble and loving God Who is first shown to the world in the humility of a manger!
