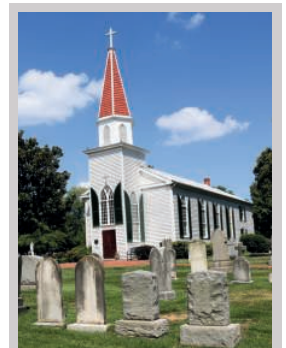

PADRE'S CORNER

How often has Our Blessed Mother intervened to protect her children?! Have you ever wondered why October is dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary? The 1500s saw the Moslem Turks advancing throughout eastern Europe and the Mediterranean. The Moslem Turk Navy was a juggernaut that few could withstand – the Knights of Malta defeated it in 1564. Just seven years after the defeat in Malta, the Turkish Navy appeared along the southeast coast of Italy, near the town of Lepanto. It was set to decimate the hodge-podge Christian armada that had never fought as a unit. Pope St. Pius V had implored the various Christian rulers to compile a force to stop the Turkish Navy. This force was to meet at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. Pope Pius V had been a Dominican and was devoted to Our Lady. He asked every Christian in Europe to pray the Rosary for protection and victory.

As the day unfolded, the wind changed to favor the Christian forces. The Christian leader, Don Juan of Austria, had a Crucifix mounted to the main mast of his ship. This Crucifix is reported to have bowed to him as the battle began. By the end of the day, the Turkish forces were destroyed, thousands of Christian slaves were liberated, and Europe was spared a Turkish invasion.

St. Pius V had already begun prayers of thanksgiving for the victory before any messengers arrived in Rome. For, he had been given a vision of the battle. In gratitude to Our Lord and Our Lady, he named October 7th the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary

October is the month of Our Lady of the Rosary. It is a tremendous Scriptural prayer wherein we ponder Our Lord's Life while honoring His Mother. How many Catholics have used this method of prayer in the form that Our Lady gave to St. Dominic in the early 1200s.


