The Lamb Center– 703-691-3178 - A daytime center in Fairfax offering hot meals, laundry, shower facilities, help with job search, transportation assistance, haircuts, support groups, medical & dental clinic, computer access, assistance in applying for Social Security benefits, and bible study groups. All food and services are free. Please call or feel free to drop in: Mon-Fri 8am-3pm & Sat 8am-12:30pm.

Fairfax Detoxification Center – 703-502-7000 – available 24/7 – provides free, short-term residential program for adults who need help to safely detoxify from the effects of drugs and/or alcohol.

Shepherd Center of Fairfax-Burke – 703-323-4788 – offers free transportation to medical appts, therapy, or rehab for senior adults ages 50 and over. Please call during business hours.

Just Neighbors – 703-979-1240 – offers immigration legal services to immigrants, asylees, and refugees with low/no income. Please call during business hours.
